

FINDINGS FROM CHAMPS: IN-DEPTH INVESTIGATIONS OF CAUSES OF CHILD DEATHS IN HIGH-MORTALITY SETTINGS

Dr. Whitney has served as the Principal Investigator and Executive Director of the Child Health and Mortality Prevention Surveillance (CHAMPS) program since 2020, leading efforts to accurately identify causes of child mortality across seven countries using advanced diagnostic techniques. She is a Professor at Emory University's Rollins School of Public Health, with prior experience as Chief of the Respiratory Diseases Branch at the CDC, where she specialized in pneumococcal disease, pneumonia, and vaccine policy.
