Vincent Escuyer obtained his Doctorate in Pharmacy from Université Paris Cité and PhD in Microbiology from the Pasteur Institute in Paris, France followed by a post-doctoral fellowship at Harvard Medical School. Since 2007, He is the director of Mycobacteriology at Wadsworth Center, the New York State Public Health laboratory. He is a consultant for the Global Tuberculosis Institute at Rutgers University, one of the four National Tuberculosis Centers of Excellence funded by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention that provides training, education and medical consultation to healthcare professionals. His research focuses on the development, validation, and implementation of advanced genomic and molecular diagnostic platforms - including whole-genome sequencing, targeted next-generation sequencing, and phage-based assays.
